## **SCALFORD PRODUCE and CRAFT SHOW**



### **GENERAL GUIDANCE FOR EXHIBITORS**

- Read the 'Schedule of Classes' (page 4) to ensure that your entries comply with the rules.
- Exhibits must be brought to the church between 8.30 and 10.00 am.
- All exhibits should be clean and hygienic.
- Judges may cut and/or taste some exhibits.

### **FRUIT AND VEGETABLES**

- Three vegetables with a similar size and shape are required for each exhibit entered.
- Exhibits should be washed clean of soil and decaying leaves.
- Trim foliage and stalks off root vegetables.
- Remove any loose skin, tidy roots, and tie the tops of onions and shallots with twine.
- Pull down the husks of sweetcorn to expose corn on the cob.
- Stalks should be left on fruit.

### **FLOWERS**

- Keep to the number of blooms stipulated; ensure they conform to size.
- Remove any faded flowers or foliage.
- Select flowers and stems with a similar size.
- Ensure that Flower Arrangements can be viewed from all sides.

### **HOMECRAFT**

- Edible produce may be tasted by the judge.
- Jars should be sealed with a lid or cover.
- Jars should be labelled with name of contents and date made.
- Homemade drinks should be in a clear bottle with an easily removed stopper.

### **HOBBIES**

- To maximise display, photographs may be fixed to the wall with Blue-Tac unless you inform the committee.

### **YOUNG PERSONS' ENTRIES**

- These classes have a maximal age requirement (up to 11 years and 11 to 18 years old) and necessitate you to write your age on the entry card.

## RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

Entry of exhibits to the show is free, everyone welcome.

Exhibits must be received between 8.30 and 10.00 am on the day of the show.

Exhibits will be finally staged by the Committee.

Exhibits must be the bona fide property of, and grown or made by, the exhibitor.

The show committee cannot take responsibility for any damage to exhibits.

Exhibitors must provide their own containers, vases or plates.

Photographs should not be mounted.

Exhibits not to be auctioned should be removed before 3.15 pm and the entry card for them should be marked 'NOT FOR AUCTION'.

Judging will occur between 10.00 and 11.00 am.

The judges' decision will be final.

Prizes (rosettes) will be awarded for each class to: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

Points will be awarded for each class as follows: 1st - 3 points, 2nd - 2 points, 3rd - 1 point.

Trophies will be awarded according to points accumulated in certain categories or to the judges' assessment of quality of the exhibit in other categories.

The auction of exhibits will commence at 3.00 pm in the church.

A plant sale and seed swap will also be available on the day, together with light refreshments.

The show has been organised by the Scalford Produce and Craft Show Committee on behalf of St Egelwin's church. All profits will go to St Egelwin's.

Except for personal injury or death caused by its negligence, the organisers exclude all liability howsoever caused (including but not limited to negligence). This exclusion includes, but is not limited to, liability for loss or damage to exhibits.
